IN THE VINEYARD

Devil's Gulch, located in western Marin County, got its name due to its treacherous terrain. The vineyard, planted in 1980, is made up of steep terraces and shallow soils and when combined with the harsh climate of the Marin coast, results in small yields and berries that have a distinct expression.

CONVERSATIONS WITH THE WINEMAKER

The grapes were hand-harvested between October 6, 2021 and fermented in open-top vats with hand punchdowns occurring twice a day, after which the must is basket-pressed and barrel-aged 15 months in French oak, 40% new.

TASTING NOTES

The captivating Devil's Gulch Pinot Noir unfurls with vibrant aromas of alluring spice, intricately layered with notes of sweet wild berries and enchanting nutmeg. Delight your palate with the luscious flavors, accented by a touch of aromatic bay leaf. This exceptional Pinot Noir exhibits a pleasing density that embraces the senses, while the savory finish leaves a profound and enduring impression that lingers gracefully.
